Our events calendar is to be published sometime in January which will see 2024 be broken into two halves to allow members get to as many events as possible.

We look to get some new merchandise in the New Year with Villa scarves to be available for purchase within the 1st quarter. We will try to have them in stock before our Junior Cup game against St. Peters to create a sea of Green and White to make the Villa twelfth man an asset to the boys. When the scarves are gone, they're gone.

The academy has seen a very festive and fun Christmas period for all the kids involved with blitzes played in the run up to Santa arriving.

The former player tracker has started with our lads abroad. Our League of Ireland representation will begin in the new season.

National Competition front our Premier team won their 100th game in the current era in style with a comprehensive 11-0 win against Cork Intero in the Munster Junior Cup in Mayfield. They played Peake Villa in the Munster Champions Cup a week later which saw them win 2-1 in extra time putting them through to the Munster Champions Final, so a big turn out by our 12th man is needed to help the boys bring it home. Our U15s bowed out of the SFAI cup with a tough 2-0 loss to Bagnelstown of Carlow. The U14 girls were due for SFAI cup action against Peake Villa of Thurles but given a walkover thus move on to the next round.

Out U12A team are going abroad to Bergues, France in May to compete on the international stage in the Bergues City Tournament. Our U13A team are going abroad to Malgrat de Mar, Spain in May to compete in the international Whitsuntide Cup Tournament.

Team Spotlight



This majority of this group have been together for the past 3 seasons. Having missed out on a lot of SSG's tournaments due to Covid when they were in the Villa Academy this group were entered into the U'11C League in their first season of competitive football to get them used to playing games. They reached the Cup final that season but were beaten 2-1 by Carrick Utd.

Last season they had a really strong showing in the U'11A League finishing second to eventual winners Southend Utd and beating Piltown in the cup final on a score line of 2-0.

So far this season they have not played any league games due to the consistent wet weather conditions. They have won all 4 rounds of the South East Region SFAI Cup competition and qualified for the regional semi-final. They have been drawn at home against our great rivals Southend Utd in the national last 32 open draw which is due to take place early in the New Year. The boys in this squad have an excellent attendance record at training sessions and are always eager to work hard on improving their game.

France Trip May 2024:

This squad have been entered into the U'12 Bergues City Tournament that takes place on the May Bank Holiday weekend 2024. Bergues is a historical town located close to Dunkirk in Northern France. This is an excellent opportunity for the boys to travel away together for a tournament and to test themselves against teams from France. The group are planning some fundraising events in the New Year to help in some way towards the cost of the trip.

Our main focus with this group since we took them from the academy has always been to educate them on the basics of the game and improve them as footballers.

Rafa joined our coaching team last season and has done tremendous work with both of our goalkeepers. This season Iuri volunteered his services to work with the squad on improving their fitness levels. A portion of each training session is now dedicated to fitness, endurance and speed work.

We have followed the Villa FC Football Development Programme when compiling our training sessions throughout the last 2 seasons. This is a modular programme that covers different age related principles of the game in 4 to 5 week blocks. This season we also designed a position specific playbook for each member of the squad that they can use as a reference.

Month in Review

We had a quiet start to December, as on the first weekend of the month a lot of our lads were involved in the Waterford Oscar Traynor Squad who were in action against the Munster Senior League's Junior Selection, in which the Waterford League ran out 2-0 winners.

We then began a busy period of 3 games in 7 days where we first travelled to Cork for a Munster Junior Cup last 32 tie where we faced Helio Inter Cork. The game was played on a tight Astro pitch in Mayfield but the lads had their shooting boots on and hat tricks from Alex Phelan & Regix Madika along with goals from Conor Whittle, Conor Kilgannon, Eoghan Rea, Nils Lukaku and Shane O Brien made it a comfortable afternoon in an 11-0 win. This result puts us into the last 16 of the Munster Junior Cup where we host last year's holders Regional Utd on Sun Jan 7th in what should be a cracker of a game.

Portlaw travelled to Connor's Park on Wedneday the 13th Dec where we played our first game in over 12 months on the grass pitch which our groundsman Decky Purcell had in fantastic condition as always. A hat trick of assists from John Fred Tamen was the highlight of the game, slipping Alex Phelan in for the first, crossing for Conor Kilgannon for the second and winning the penalty for the third which Dean Walsh converted to complete a 3-0 win.

It was great to get a league game played during what's been a busy cup schedule and this important 3 points puts us back on the top of the table heading into the New Year. A quick turnaround from Portlaw on the Wednesday night to Sunday afternoon which brought about our biggest game of the season to date, away to Peake Villa in the Semi Final of the Munster Champions Trophy.

Peake Villa, who last season saw off serial winners St. Michaels to win the Tipperary League, were also unbeaten so far this season heading into this game.

A soft pitch in Thurles with a strong wind made it a tough day to play good football and Peake scored a couple minutes before half time to lead 1-0 at the break.

We showed more composure and bravery on the ball in the second half, created some chances and had Peake reduced to 10 men but it didn't look as if it was going to be our day. However Conor Kilgannon had other plans and his low drive from 20 yards in the 93rd minute levelled the game and brought it into extra time.

We had the majority of possession within extra time but Craig Dunphy was called into action to make a big save from a Peake counter attack. Into added time in extra time the tie looked destined for penalties, but one final attack saw the ball fall to the edge of the box to Conor Whittle who's trademark finesse finish to the top corner had the Villa team and supporters erupt with celebrations and puts us through to the Munster Champions Trophy Final.

The draw for the FAI Junior Cup last 32 was also made last week with us receiving a home tie against St. Peters of Athlone, to be played Sun Jan 21st at 2pm.

Coaches Notes

"Another strong month for us with 3 really important results picked up along the way."

"We've had a number of trips down to Cork this season already and made light work of what was a potential banana skin against Helio Inter. They were a very aggressive team who left the foot in so it was great to come out of there with no injuries along with the result."

"Our game v Portlaw was a tricky encounter for the first half hour until we made the breakthrough. Portlaw came and sat in a low block and they were a threat on the counter early in the game, but once we scored the first goal it settled us down and it was great to keep another clean sheet and pick up another 3 points."

"We were expecting a tough test away in Peake Villa, which is probably one of the toughest games in junior football at current. We were down a few bodies too which never helps on days like that but huge credit to the lads who put in a monumental shift in tough conditions. Scoring two late goals is a great pointer towards the character within the group. I was delighted to see the two Conor's (Kilgannon and Whittle) share the headlines as it was exactly what their individual performances on the day deserved."

"We'll face the winners of Newmarket Celtic or Killarney Celtic in the Final in early 2024 and that's one that we'll really look forward to"



100 games at the helm of Premier Football in Villa FC; the Coad-Byrne era has delivered us to the promise land and they aim to do it again.

When it comes to dynamic duos, the likes of Batman & Robin, Sonny & Cher, Starsky & Hutch, Penn & Teller, and Simon & Garfunkel will all come to mind. However we are fortunate enough to have our own duo that has brought equal amounts of magic, excellence, and glory to Villa FC; that being the managerial pairing of Conor Coad and Paddy Byrne.

Both men have a rich history with the club bringing silverware to our doorstep as players, but the calling of managerial pursuits has led them to revitalise football within Villa FC and establish a beautiful style of play now synonymous with the famous Green and White of Villa. They have also been laying a foundation of footballing excellence while building, not just the most exciting team in Waterford Junior football at the moment, but the most extraordinary team and backroom staff to accompany it. A special mention to Paul Morrissey who was a vital source of experience and advice that is still with the squad to this day.

When Conor and Paddy took the reins of the Premier squad in August of 2018, it saw them install a new style of fluid play, keep the team together through 2+ years of a global pandemic, bolster the squad with ever improving players from the Villa rank and file, and not just compete but reach and win national finals to add the clubs name to a very prestigious roster of national teams we are delighted to be a part of.

The 2021-2022 season was the clubs most successful in its junior history by finally breaking the spectre that loomed over the club by never having won a junior league title. Not only did we win our first league, we also went on to win the FAI junior cup, becoming the forth Waterford team to do so, joining the likes of other great Waterford teams such as Waterford Crystal and Carrick.

With entry into many other competitions for the 2023-2024 season, the Coad and Byrne era look to build on their legacy and collect as much silverware as possible with an even more experienced and improved squad.

The Coaching Unit and Backroom Staff is what keeps the Engine Roaring

The success of the team would not have got to where it has been performing at without the massive help and commitment of the backroom staff that are involved with the team.

The work that Devan Morrissey, John Butler, Stephen Cleere, Paul Morrissey, and Johnny Arrigan put into the lads is behemoth in nature and thankfully it is paying dividends for the club as we are currently in our most successful period in history. Without them, the engine will stall or cut out at the most important times, so a massive thanks to all them for what they do.

Success - The Stats Speak for themselves

In the first 100 games since taking over, there have been 80 games won, 8 draws, and 12 losses. This sees a win % of 80% for the tenure so far which is impressive for any team in any league. This highlights how the team have spearheaded what is being done within the club and to install and implement the correct fundamentals across all levels of the Villa football pyramid.

What is even more impressive across these 100 games, is that we have scored 330+ goals and conceded less than 100. That is an approximate 3:1 ratio which is testament to our defensive and attacking capabilities.

Our 100th game in this era was against Helio Inter Cork FC of the Cork business league in the Munster Junior Cup which saw the lad's record their biggest ever win margin with the game finishing up 11-0. Other games were played to carry the Coad-Byrne era past the 100 mark with our final home game of the 2023 calendar year playing host to newly promoted Portlaw (3-0 win) and a massive away day to Peake Villa in the Munster Champions Cup semi-final (2-1 win) that has set up a massive final for the lads with venue and time yet to be determined as of writing this.

What does the Future Hold?

The question on everyone's lips within the club is what is the next chapter of this ever expanding tale? With the Coad and Byrne era not looking to stop anytime soon, with the full buy in from these mega talented players, with ever improving football pathways from academy to premier, more players using football as a vehicle to achieve academic and professional success, and a backroom team that attracts the best and brightest from within the county's football community, only the future will tell what will happen with the club.

A Message from the Committee

Player Registration – 2023/24 Season

This season the Football Association of Ireland (FAI) introduced a new player registration and match management system called FAI Connect and Comet. The system is based on an internationally established football management system used in several other European countries and further afield.

FAI Connect will be the central point for all football administration from the League of Ireland to the grassroots game and make football easier to manage for coaches, players, Club administrators, referees and volunteers.

Villa FC implementation was spearheaded by Derek Breslin. Derek lead the complex transition to the player registration element of FAIConnect. This involved a complete review of all current and incoming players across the three leagues - schoolgirls and women's league, schoolboy league and junior league players. The compilation of player information for several hundred players was a huge task. Supported by our team coaches, players and parents Villa FC now has almost 700 active registered players on the system - each one assigned to their individual team(s). Derek also coordinated the registration of our coaches on the system. We also had the expert guidance of our own Craig Dunphy in his official role with the FAI.

The benefits of this hard work will be long lasting as player registrations will now roll over from season to season and transfers between clubs can be managed online thus significantly reducing the administration burden. Additionally match day administration will reduce for coaches and team managers. Locally the Junior League and all local Clubs as well as the Referees Society have fully adopted the match management function for several divisions. This activity is operated via the linked "Comet" App. This allows team selection, live match updates such as goals, substitutions, cautions etc to be accessible to all via the FAIConnect App.

Many thanks to Derek and Craig for the great work on this project.

If you haven't already download the FAI Connect App it is available via the usual App Stores on Apple and Android devices - you can follow all Villa FC Junior League games live and as each league implements the match day functions all teams will be online.
