This year has seen our return to 1A action for the first time in 7 years after we won the 1B League title last year. The squad consists of the same core group of players and with coaches Dev Morrissey & Paddy Byrne staying at the helm once again and fortunately we have seen the addition of the brilliant Stephen Cleere to the coaching staff.

The squad is a young but eager and determined group of players who are really looking forward to another step in their men's football journey at a very competitive level, seeing us compete against a multiple of Waterford's senior teams club's looking to get to the Premier League. This brings a whole new level of desire to the group as they want to see themselves as the top team in the division regardless of how young they all are. It is a credit to them as men and as players to see them have this attribute at the forefront of every training and every game.

The team are currently sitting on top of the 1A league table at 19 points with 6 wins and 1 draw. The challenge of taking the step up in division has been like a duck to water, albeit against challenging competition.

We recently saw off Tycor AFC, beating them 4-1 at home. It was a win that saw us return to the top of the league table, now unbeaten in 6 games. An impressive feat for this young group in their debut 1A season. We saw 170+ people along the fences for the home game versus Tycor and look to grow this support with the 1A's while also feeding that support into many other team in the pyramid.

There are a lot of top teams that have still to be met in the league, but one challenge that this group won't shy away from.

Month in Review

Our Premier side had 4 games this month and picked up 4 wins to continue our strong start to the season. We hosted Piltown in the last 64 of the Munster Junior Cup at the start of the month and ran out convincing 6-1 winners.

Our second game of the month was in the FAI Junior Cup with a home game against Hibs and a strong first half performance had the game wrapped up and we ran out 6-2 winners.

A return to league action for our third game in November where we hosted Carrick Utd and even though we were a man down for over an hour we still managed to put in a composed performance to win 4-0.

Our final game of the month was in the last 64 of the FAI Junior Cup away to Monread FC of the Leinster Senior League and despite a tight pitch and interesting refereeing performance we got the result winning 3-2 and putting our names in the hat for the last 32 of the competition in the New Year.

We've had some really strong performances so far this season all over the pitch, with a huge amount of controlled possession within our build up, lots of aggressive pressing but the most pleasing aspect has been the attacking firepower being displayed.

Dean Walsh is leading the way with 16 goals and 12 assists from his 11 apps to date. Regix Madika is also into double figures with 10 goals and Alex Phelan is chipping in too with 6 goals so far.

Our midfield players are contributing big numbers as well with Conor Whittle on 7 goals and 11 assists to date, Conor Kilgannon 6 goals and 6 assists and Adam Conway also with 4 goals and 5 assists.

Ravelli Kilonda, 2 goals and 5 assists and John Fred Tamen with 6 assists are ensuring our wide threat is ever present.

Craig Dunphy, Dylan Walsh, Conor Signorelli and Luke Walsh, have put in consistent solid performances all month to give us a solid base through the spine of our team.

It's been fantastic to see young players like Dylan Nolan, Shane O' Brien and in particular Dylan Stickel play a big role within our Premier side so far this season.

It's also been great to see players returning from injuries and start to make an impact such as Eoghan Rea, new signing Lekan Oki and Tyres Kennedy who got himself on the scoresheet against Carrick.

We look forward to welcoming our Captain Adam Heaslip back from a fractured arm in the New Year along with the return of Aaron O Connor from Australia both of whom will have a big influence when back involved.

Coaches Notes

In a small talk with Conor on the past month, he says, "We've had a strong month overall with our Premier side where we continued to progress in both FAI and Munster Junior Competitions along with extending our 100% record in the league."

Looking forward to December, Conor mentions, "A really difficult December lies ahead where we have 4 games in 14 days, including 3 away games in a row, starting with a massive league game away v Tramore on Wed 6th Dec before a tricky trip to Cork v Cork Helio International on Sun 10th Dec in the Munster Junior followed up by a huge clash away v Peake Villa in the Munster Champions Trophy Semi Final on Sun 17th Dec before another potential league game pencilled in for Wed 20th."

He continues on by saying, "All the players and backroom staff will be working hard to ensure we approach each game with the right attitude and mindset"

Finally, he wants to emphasis, "A huge thanks to all club members who support the lads week in week out and with an action packed month ahead we'd love to see big crowds travelling to support the team."




Youth A
